6. Entries will be submitted into the ‘Best’ in the chosen medium and ‘People’s Choice’ Awards.
7. Entries in this section must comply with all Exhibition conditions apart from Junior entries in relation to Item 6.

Conditions of Entry

- Entry Forms can be copied if you submit more than 3 entries (Pairs are accepted as one entry).
- All work must be the original work of exhibitor. No photographs unless part of mixed medium work.
- Works—framed or on canvas must be securely wired ready to hang.
- Entries still 'wet' will not be accepted.
- The Committee of the Community Bank Beaufort Pyrenees Art Exhibition reserves the right to not hang any work. Acceptance or refusal will be at the Committee's discretion.
- All works on display must be available for sale and the exhibitor will pay a commission of 20% to the Committee on any works sold.
- The exhibitor must pay all freight charges both forward and return & instructions (eg. Post, Courier, etc.) must be advised. Exhibit label must show the same details as the entry form.
- Exhibits will be received at the Beaufort Town Hall in Lawrence Street on Sunday 2nd June between 12 and 4pm and Tuesday 4th June between 10am and 4pm.**
- All works shall remain on display for the duration of the Exhibition ie. until 2pm Monday, 10th June, 2024. They can be collected after 2pm and before 4pm from the Beaufort Town Hall. Any works nominated to be collected and not picked up on Monday can be collected from the Beaufort Information & Resource Centre, 72 Neill Street, Beaufort from 12.00pm Tuesday, 11th June. Paintings will only be held for two weeks after which they will be returned to the artist at the artist's expense.
- The type of medium must be indicated on the entry form and the exhibit label. The Committee reserves the right to nominate the type of medium should you fail to indicate.
- The Decisions of the Judge will be final.
- Any damage or loss of an exhibit howsoever and wherever occurring and whether whilst in transit, on display, in storage or otherwise shall be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. The Committee will take every care with exhibits, but does not accept any responsibility for any such damage or loss and advises all exhibitors to insure exhibits against any such loss or damage.
- The Committee reserves the right to reproduce any exhibit for publicity purposes in all forms of media for the purpose of advertising the Community Bank Beaufort Pyrenees Art Exhibition.
- The Committee will produce and have available a catalogue of entries exhibited and showing the names of the Exhibitors. Whilst making every effort to produce a complete and correct listing the Committee will accept no responsibility for any error, omission or misdescription or any defect in the catalogue.
- Payment to artists of prize money and sale proceeds will be forwarded by cheque or bank transfer as soon as possible after the event and at the latest, within one calendar month of the exhibition closing.
- The Committee does not collect G.S.T. All prices must be total selling price. Any G.S.T. liability between the artist and the A.T.O. remains the responsibility of the artist.
